



WATERPERRY FARM

Visitor Guidelines and Policies

We encourage all visitors to Waterperry Farm to explore and enjoy our various gardens and collections. Feel free to walk on all the trails and gravel roads, as well as any mowed grassy areas. While visiting, please remember that botanical gardens are living museums and outdoor laboratories. We ask that you respect the collection by following these rules:

- To protect the unique specimens in the Waterperry's collection and reduce the spread of plant pests and diseases, **PLEASE DO NOT BRING ANY OUTSIDE PLANT MATERIAL TO WATERPERRY FARM.**
- Do not climb trees or stone walls.
- Do not disturb plant tags or labels.
- Do not pick flowers or collect any plants or plant parts, including seeds, leaves, pine cones, and acorns.
- Do not disturb wildlife, including snakes and insects.
- Do not walk in the garden beds.
- Remote control vehicles, including aerial drones, are prohibited.
- Bikes and scooters (except mobility aids) may only be ridden on paved and gravel roads.

Waterperry Farm is striving to eliminate single-use plastics, such as plastic straws and cutlery, single use plastic and polystyrene food service containers, disposable plastic bags, and single use plastic water bottles. Please join us in our efforts by bringing a refillable water bottle when you visit, and by bringing compostable or reusable food containers and utensils should you plan to picnic. Water bottles may be filled at the pool house.

"Waterperry" is an open WiFi available in most of the garden.
